



THE SHOPS AT GEORGETOWN PARK: RENOVATION






In the 2000's the Shops at Georgetown Park suffered from declining interest in indoor malls and an increase in major retailers on the main Georgetown corridor, M Street.

 leases with TJ Maxx,
 HomeGoods, and
 DSW
- This is a major shift for the mall, from smaller high-end boutiques to big-box discount stores.



THE SHOPS AT GEORGETOWN PARK: RENOVATION

305,000 SF indoor mall in upscale Georgetown neighborhood in Washington, DC

- 1981: The Shops at Georgetown Park opens for business
- 2010: Vornado purchases property at auction for \$61 Million
- 2010-2014: Renovation Period (lease expirations, construction)
- August 2014: Vornado sells property to Jamestown Properties for \$272.5
 Million
